### British Water Polo League

All three teams have now played their second round matches:-

The **Lizards** team traveled to Coventry to play in the new 50m pool and beat Hucknall but lost out to Coventry leaving them fourth in Division One. They just need one more win to secure a place in the Super Fives in Phase Two of the season

The **Liver Birds** team went to Marlborough and beat Welsh Wanderers and Sheffield Stingrays but lost to Mid Sussex Marlins which puts them second in Division Two. Another win will see them qualify for Championship One in Phase Two of the season.

The **Water Beetles** team were at home in Liverpool for their second round of matches but couldn't manage to win their games against Southampton, St. Andrews and Cheltenham.
