Dear Swimmers & Parents

After much consideration and discussion between Mike Roberts (Head Coach) and Bryan Langley (Chairman) it has been decided that there will NOT be a swim camp in October 2014.

This is a decision which has not been taken lightly but unfortunately when presented with the figures Mike and Bryan both agreed that it would be too much of a financial burden to place onto the club, the swimmers and their parents.

The estimated cost at the time the figures were presented to Mike and Bryan was in the region of £770 which was felt to be too high to be financially viable and this was with flights leaving Manchester Airport on Saturday evening which would mean arriving at the hotel at midnight which would effectively mean the swimmers would not be getting into the pool until Sunday afternoon.

With the increasing cost of the swim camp, the subject of fund raising is one which must be taken into account when planning future swim camps, if the overall cost of the camp is one which is to be more affordable to the club and parents alike. Both Mike and Bryan agree that one of the conditions for future selection for swim camps will depend on the swimmers willingness to take part in fundraising activities.

Plans for a swim camp in 2015 either at Easter or October will begin within the next few months and it is hoped to have a fund raising committee in place as these plans progress.
